grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **B.E. Waldrop: The following described property to-wit:** situated and being in the County and State aforesaid, lying near Judson Mills known as lots number 5 and 6 and 6a, formerly known as lots number 5 and 6 on plat of property of J.O. Heatherly, made by Fitzpatrick Terry Co. Engineers, March 1920, and recorded in office of Greenville County, Book E., page 238, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron on the North side of Heatherly drive, corner of lot number 4 and running thence with lot number 4, in a Northeasternly direction 146 feet to iron pin, corner of property sold by W.S. Ward to the Judson Mills; thence along with line of Judson Mills property South E. direction 59.7 feet to iron pin; thence along Judson Mills property in a Northern direction 138 feet more or less, to a stake on P. & N. R.Y. right-of-way; thence with said right of way in a north E. direction 55.1 feet to iron pin; thence S. 38-58 W. 257.6 feet, more or less to iron pin on heatherly drive; thence with Heatherly Drive N. 60-26 W. 130.2 feet to the beginning corner.
