with interest thereon, from the day of Nov 1922 at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; and interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of five besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,  
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward Six of the City of Greenville in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot Number Four and a part of the property of C. B. Martin, and J. A. Hicks, as shown by W. C. Dalton, C. C. November 1922, and being more particularly described as follows, to wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin on Elm Street One Hundred Twenty five and 3/10 feet from the Northwest intersection of Elm and Otis Streets, and running thence North 62 degrees 17 min. East, One Hundred Twenty two and 5/10 feet to an iron pin - joint corner of Lots Four and Five Thence S. 19 degrees 8 min. East Fifty nine and 7/10 feet to an iron pin - joint corner of Lots Three and Four; thence South 55 degrees 33 min West One hundred Three and 4/10 feet to an iron pin on Elm Street; thence North 36 degrees 10 min. West Seventy two feet to the beginning corner.
