Also that certain tract of or parcel of land situated and being in State ~~and~~ County, as aforesaid and in ~~Sumpter~~ Township and on the East side of the Old Augusta Road on ~~Limestone~~ Creek containing Sixty (60a) acres, more or less. Beginning on stake #1N in said road bed, below the graveyard, thence along said road ~~bed~~ to stone #111 on W. V. Davenport line; thence N. 05 E. 31.50 to stone #111, thence N. 36³⁰ E. 12.70 to stone #111; thence S. 55 W. 16.00 to a stone #111, thence N. 43 W. 4.00 to stone #111; thence S. 55 W. 35⁰⁰ to beginning corner.

Also also that piece parcel of tract of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid ~~Sumpter~~ Township adjoining the above tract containing Fourteen and ~~100~~ (14.41a) acres more or less, and having the following ~~width~~ and bounds to wit: Beginning on a stone #111 in ~~the~~ Old Augusta Road bed and W.
