

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Beulah Gaither of Greenville County, said State of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Beulah Gaither in and by me certain note or obligation, bearing date the 14th day of January 1924:

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 14th day of January A. D. 1924, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that I the said Beulah Gaither shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of February 1924, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of

Thirty three and 34/100 Dollars, (Twenty Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Twenty Shares of Stock, and Thirteen and 24/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Thirty and 66/100 Dollars, (Twenty Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Ten and 66/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Twenty-eight Dollars, (Twenty Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and eight Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seventy five and 34/100 Dollars, (Twenty Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Five and 34/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty two and 66/100 Dollars, (Twenty Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Two and 66/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Twenty shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made I, the said Beulah Gaither and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said Beulah Gaither in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Beulah Gaither in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also, in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said Beulah Gaither in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the city of Greenville, lot no. Twenty nine of a sub-division of land represented by a plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said Greenville County in Plat Book E. page 132, said lot has the following metes and bounds: Beginning on south side of Parker Street corner of lot number 31, thence with Parker Street N. 48-49 E. 60.6 feet to corner of lot 28; thence S. 42 E. 130 feet to corner of lot 27; thence S 48 W. 64.5 feet; thence N. 40.15 W. 130.7 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to me by B.C. Woodward, deed dated August 11, 1923, and recorded in the said R.M.C. office in deed book 97 Page 483.
