TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That, We, Isaac Parksdale and Sallie Parksdale
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, We, the said Isaac Parksdale and Sallie Parksdale
in and by ourselves certain note or obligation, bearing date the 27th day of May 1924

are indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,
duly incorporated under the laws of such State) in the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) Dollars,
with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum payable monthly from the 27th day of May A. D. 1924,

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that
the said Isaac Parksdale, Sallie Parksdale shall pay or cause to be paid to the said
Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of June

1924, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) Dollars,
being the regular monthly installment payable on the value (12) Shares of Stock, and Eight + 20/100 (\$8.00)

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance of loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the
sum of Eight + 40/100 (\$8.40) Dollars, (\$12.00) Dollars, being the the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four + 70/100 (\$4.70) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months the sum of Eight + 50/100 (\$8.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four + 80/100 (\$4.80) Dollars,
being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Fifteen + 20/100 (\$15.20)

Dollars, (\$12.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and
the sum of Three + 20/100 (\$3.20) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the

sum of Thirteen + 60/100 (\$13.60) Dollars, (\$12.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and
the sum of One + 60/100 (\$1.60) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said value (12)
shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by us to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made. Yes the said

according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to us

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents. (The receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and
Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the City of Greenville, being lots B and N of a sub-division
of land represented by a plat recorded in Plat Book C
Page 13. Lot B fronts each side of Crehoun Street thirty five
(35) feet and nine (9) inches and has a depth of One
hundred (100) feet and was conveyed to Arlie Parksdale,
M^{rs} Cullough and Isaac Parksdale by C. C. Hood and
by recent deed by Arlie Parksdale M^{rs} Cullough to Isaac
Parksdale. Lot N fronts a ten (10) foot alley, thirty five
(35) feet and nine (9) inches with a depth of One
hundred (100) feet and was conveyed to Sallie Park-
sdale by C. C. Hood and dated October 1st 1923
and recorded in Volume 82, Page 317 C. M. C. Office
for Greenville County.
