WHEREAS, I, H.A. Hollingsworth

in the full and just sum of Two hundred and fifty
Dollars, to be paid in two equal instalments of One hundred and twenty-five Dollars, and
all interest due on the eighth day December 1924 and December eighth 1925.

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be

added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A.Reid Wood, All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land

situate, lying, being in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County in the State aforesaid,
having the following courses, metes, bounds and distances to-wit" Beginning at an iron pin
in Brushy Creek road on east side of Maple Swamp, and runs thence N. 41, W. 1018 feet to an
iron pin, 124 feet to iron pin on Woods line (thence N. 75,12" E.) thence S. 45,13" E.
807' 5" to iron pin; thence N. 76' 51" E. 236' 4" to iron pin in road on Woods line; thence
S. 30' 51" W. 194' 7" feet to iron pin in road; thence S. 51' 36" W. 153' 7" feet to iron
thence S. 64.30 W. 90 feet to the beginning, four acres, more or less, being a portion of
