with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,

who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent. (10%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ola B. Gilreath: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land

near the City of Greenville, in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot Number Five (5) on plat of "Augusta Place" made by R.E. Dalton, Engr. May, 1923, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F., page 129, and more fully described as follows: Beginning at a stake on corner of lot number four on Augusta Place Street, and running thence N. 26-30 W. 274.5 feet to a stake at rear corner of lot number four; thence N. 63-30 E. 60 feet to a stake on rear corner of lot number Six; thence along line of lot number Six S. 26-30 E. 269.2 feet to a stake on Augusta Place Street; thence along said Street S. 58-30 W. 60.23 feet to the beginning corner. The premises herein conveyed are the same as conveyed to me by J.S. Belk and H.C. Robinson by deed dated January 18th, 1924, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 83, page 110.
