with interest thereon, from February 19 24, at the rate of 5 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of One per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said ~~last~~ sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Henry P. McGee,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Henry P. McGee,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry P. McGee, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece or parcel of land in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, about two miles from Greenville Court House, on the East side of Turman Road - and having a frontage of 51.04 feet on said Turman Road and a depth on one side of 142 feet and on other side of about 153 feet; more or less, being Lot No. 4 on a plat recorded in Plat Book 2, page 122 R. H. C. Greenville County, conveyed to me this day by said Henry P. McGee, also all that tract of land situated in County and State aforesaid, being a part of the subdivision known as Sans Souci Highlands, containing one acre, more or less, and bounded by H. R. Quinn and said H. A. Quinn, conveyed to me by Greenville Investment, 23^d April, 1923, and recorded in Vol. 12, page 93, R. H. C. Greenville County, South Carolina.
