until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

said County and State, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. H. Donaldson, his heirs and assigns forever all that certain piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in Austin Township containing fifty four and three fourths acres more or less and known as the Elizabeth M. Daniel place on the waters of Laurel Creek and adjoining lands of John Smith, Peter Brinson, Mrs F. N. Blakley et al being the same tract deeded to me by F. W. M. M. P. et al Blakley by deed bearing date 3rd May 1919 and recorded in Vol 54 Page 281 R. M. C Office Greenville County S. C. Car.
