 interest be at any time past due and unpaid when the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
 who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage and note further providing for attorney's fee of

 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the state of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, described as follows, to wit:
 Beginning at a point in the south side of the old Spartburg Road (North Street ex-terred) at the Northwest corner of the lot of F. Scott Davenport, and running thence South $6\frac{2}{3}$ deg. 19 min. West along the south side of said Spartburg Road Sixty-three feet to an iron pin; thence South $3\frac{1}{2}$ deg. 46 min. East One hundred Eighty-three and $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot Number Twenty-four of "Overbrook Property"; thence North $5\frac{1}{2}$ deg. 19 min. East Sixty-one and $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin; thence North $3\frac{1}{2}$ deg. 15 min. West One hundred Seventy and $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake on said Spartburg road the point of beginning. The lot of land herein conveyed is a part of West half of Lot Twenty-seven and the East Part of lot number Twenty-six of Overbrook Property, according to a map or plat thereof as made September 17, 1913, by H.
