computed and paid on monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible, as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,
reference being thereunto had, shall more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.A. Hopkins, All that tract or lot of land in Greenville County
State of South Carolina on the Cedar Falls Road, and Reedy River, containing Two hundred and
Fifty acres, more or less, being the same tract devised to me in the eighth Clause of the
Will of my father, W.V. Austin, and being the same tract of land conveyed to the said F.M.-
Austin by W.A. Harrison by deed dated May 11th, 1875, recorded in office of R.M.C. for
Greenville County in Vol. G.G., page 395.
