in and by my certain proprietors note in writing, of even date with these presents Mr. E. J. Whilden and Ella Mauldin well and truly indebted to the note

in the full and just sum of Two thousand and no/100 (\$2,000.00) Dollars, to be paid three (3) years after date with the privilege of

anticipating the payment of the whole or any part thereof at any interest during period

with interest thereon from date at the rate of seven

per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of the amount due thereon, besides all costs and expenses of collection,

to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

in Block Five of the City of Greenville, and being a part of  
lot No. 6 as shown on plat of property of Mrs. E. J. Whilden and Ella Mauldin recorded in Book "E" at page 171 in the N. M. C. office for Greenville County, and having the following Metes and bounds,
