Also, those two certain tracts of land containing in the aggregate 10.57 acres, situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, and in the County and State aforesaid, more particularly described as follows:

(1) All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Chick Springs Township, on the Chick Springs Road about 3 miles North of the City of Greenville Court House, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Chick Springs Road (Douglas corner) and running thence with said Chick Springs Road South 39-30 West five hundred twenty-three feet five inches to an iron pin in center of said road; thence in a straight line South 70 deg. East one thousand fifty two feet to an iron pin in right of way of Southern Power Company and on Douglass western line; thence with Douglas line North 5 deg. West six hundred seventy-three feet to an iron pin, Douglas corner; thence with Douglas Southern line North 80 deg. 30 min. West five hundred ninety-one feet to beginning corner, and containing 10.39 acres, more or less.

(2) All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Chick Springs Township, on the South side of Chick Springs Road and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on Chick Springs Road, corner of G.J. Douglass and J.W. Griffith land, and running thence with old line South 78 deg. 45 min. East Two hundred ninety-two feet to intersection of New Line; thence with new line North 69 deg. West Two hundred sixty-seven feet to New corner at center of Chick Springs Road; thence with said Chick Springs Road South 38 deg. West fifty-six feet to beginning corner, containing 18/100 acres, more or less.

The two tracts of land above described were conveyed to Emile Bovey by deed of J.W. Griffith dated January 1, 1925 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office in Book 105, at page 85, reference to which is hereby made.
