SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *R. J. Duncane*,
in and by *a* certain *Promissory Note*
even date with these presents, *a.m.*, well and truly indebted to *Henry P. Mc Gee*,

in the full and just sum of *Three hundred* Dollars, to be paid *Eighty dollars per year* two years from date.

with interest thereon, from *the day of* *August* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *quarterly*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Twenty five dollars* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being made thereto, had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I*, the said *R. J. Duncane*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Henry P. Mc Gee*,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said *R. J. Duncane*,

in hand well and truly paid by the said *Henry P. Mc Gee*, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Henry P. Mc Gee, his heirs and assigns*,

all that certain lot bounded to me this day by the said *Henry P. Mc Gee*, situate, lying and being in Park Place near the City of Greenville and State and County aforesaid and known, as a portion of lot No. 6, contained to said *Mc Gee* by *J. B. Beavere* 28th March, 1922 and recorded in Vol. 62, page 528 N. Y. C. Deed Book, Greenville, South Carolina, having a frontage of 45 feet on First Avenue and running back 150 feet.
