Baileys* of Greenville, South Carolina, in the full and just sum of *One hundred and twenty five dollars*, Dollars, to be paid *March 1st, 1924*.

with interest thereon, from *March 1st, 1924* at the rate of *2 1/2%* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *quarterly*.

.....until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of.....

10 years next besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note..... to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note..... reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I, W. G. Baileys*, the said *Harry Peale of Greenville, South Carolina*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *W. G. Baileys*,

according to the terms of said note....., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *W. G. Baileys*, the said *W. G. Baileys*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *W. G. Baileys*

All that piece of land and tract of ground lying situated and being in *Greenville, South Carolina*, State of *South Carolina*, bounded as the same was described to me in a deed signed by *W. G. Baileys* on the 1st day of Feb. 1924 and recorded in the office of *B. A. Hart, W. G. Baileys*, *Boogarting Bankers and *W. G. Baileys**, beginning on a white oak stump, there running N. by E. 11.65 to a stone, then N. by E. 11.91 to a S. E. 8.40, thence down Duck Creek 11.81 to the beginning corner and contains 3 9/10 acres more or less.
