TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, *Anna Cureton* SEND GREETING:  
WHEREAS, I, the said *Anna Cureton*  
in and by *my* certain *Promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents well and truly indebted to  
*The Peoples National Bank, Greenville, S.C.*  
in the full and just sum of *Two hundred <sup>70</sup>/<sub>100</sub>*  
Dollars, to be paid *Nov. 15th 1924.*

with interest thereon, from *maturity* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *annually*  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of  
*Twenty-five <sup>70</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollars* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,  
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said *Anna Cureton*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said  
*bank*  
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said  
*Anna Cureton*  
in hand well and truly paid by the said  
*bank*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said *The Peoples National Bank, Greenville, S.C.*

All my right, title and interest (same being a one-third undivided interest) as the widow of William Cureton, deceased in a tract of land in Austin Township State and County aforesaid containing 58 acres more or less, said land being the same I deeded to Aaron Walker and William Cureton by T. B. Haynes Jan 7th, 1891 and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in book 77 Page 373, the interest of Aaron Walker being conveyed to William Cureton by deed dated Nov. 17th. 1896 in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in book CCC, page 6104.
