with interest thereon from March 9th, 1924 at the rate of ..... per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid quarterly.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of all debt due  
plus expenses besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceeding, any sum of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being made thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That Elmer P. Massengill in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said  
D. E. Massengill,  
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to Elmer P. Massengill, the said  
Elmer P. Massengill in hand well and truly paid by the said D. E. Massengill

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said D. E. Massengill, his heirs and assigns forever,  
all that certain piece of land in Lincolnville township,  
Greenville County, state of South Carolina, about three  
miles south of Greenville "Exact House", known as Lot #60  
in tract of property of Ulles and Lason, recorded in Register  
of Deeds Convenants Office for said County in Flat Rock  
"E" at page 15, and being more particularly described  
as follows: Beginning at a point on the south side  
of Blue Run, Lason's lot #60, running thence with line  
of said lot in the southerly direction 172.8 feet to a stake  
thence in an easterly direction 81 feet to a stake, corner  
of lot #59, thence with line of said lot in a northerly  
direction 111.4 feet to a stake on Blue Run, thence with  
line of Blue Run in a westerly direction 86 to the point of  
beginning, this is the same lot conveyed to me the
