SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said John St. Hicks,
 in and by May certain, do owe and owe
 even date with these presents, \$1000.00
 to the said Farmers and Merchants Bank, of Greenville, S. C.
 in the full and just sum of One hundred and Ten Dollars (\$110.00)
 Dollars, to be paid on December 1, 1924

with interest thereon, from January 1, at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum, to be
 computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
 interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
 who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$100.00

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
 any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,
 reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Farmers and Merchants Bank,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to \$113.00, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
 bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers and Merchants Bank

All that certain piece, &c. of land situated
 lying and lying in the State of South Carolina, County
 of Greenville, and in Gazette Township, having boundaries
 as follows, to wit: Beginning on the North by Roads
 of John St. Hicks on the East by roads of D. L. Gandy,
 the South by roads of various Roads and on the
 West by roads of Lawrence Roads, containing forty
 five acres, more or less.

This is the same tract of land conveyed to John
