I, *Harriett Jackson* SEND GREETING:
WHEREAS, I, the said *Harriett Jackson*
in and by *a* certain *asm* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to

Bessie Edeus
in the full and just sum of *One hundred and Eight*
Dollars, to be paid *November 15th 1924*

with interest thereon, from *maturity* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

10% besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said *Harriett Jackson*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Bessie Edeus
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

Harriett Jackson
in hand well and truly paid by the said

Bessie Edeus
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said *Bessie Edeus*

All my right, title and interest all that piece, parcel
or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, Beginning at a point
on the South side of Railway - Right-of-way and run-
ning S. 14-48 E. 444 feet; thence S. 12-32 E. 31.8 feet to lot
of Vickey Carter; thence with Vickey Carter's line N.
83-25 W. 1143.8 feet to Church Street; thence with Church
Street N. 13-45 W. 453.4 feet to Railroad right-of-way;
thence S. 88-49 E. 130.2 feet to the beginning corner, ac-
cording to plat made by R. E. Dalton. My interest in
said property having been acquired by inheritance
thru my husband Ansel Arnold; this being a part
of the property conveyed by Mrs Caroline A. Mauldin
to Joel Arnold, December 13th. 1873, deed recorded
in Book FF Page 737; my children having convey-
ed their interest in said land to me.
The sense of this paper is that I am giving a
mortgage over one-fourth of this one acre on the
South side of the described property. As there are no
meets and bounds on this one-fourth acre we, therefore
described it as one-fourth of an acre on the South
side of this said property.
