until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by this note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee and costs of suit.

All that piece of land situate, lying and being in Ward One of the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid, on Tennessee Street, and having the following dimensions and bounds, to wit:

The beginning at an iron post on Tennessee Street at the corner of lot heretofore conveyed by L. J. Bridges to W. H. Guy and running thence with said Tennessee Street S. 30° 41' E. 66 1/2 feet to an iron post in corner of summons property, thence with summons line N. 69° 16' E. 118 1/2 feet to an iron post thence N. 10° 15' W. 95 feet to an iron post corner of lot heretofore conveyed to the said L.
