WHEREAS, *I*, the said *B. C. Bentley*, in and by *my* certain even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

Greene Moore Jones in the full and just sum of *Three Thousand Dollars and 00 cents (\$3,000.00)* Dollars, to be paid *one or before* *July 1st* *1921* *from* *date*.

with interest thereon, from *July 1st 1921* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid.

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

8% of the amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I*, the said *B. C. Bentley*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

J. L. Moore Jones according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. L. Moore Jones*

all that certain piece of land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and being on the South side of West Park Avenue (formerly Barker Street) - and having this following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of said street 898 feet from the South-West corner of Powers Street and Park Avenue and running thence with said Avenue, N. 76. 50 W. 50 feet to the corner of lot recorded to W. G. Henderson and L. S. Webb on March 28, 1918, thence with the line of said lot S. 13. 30 W. 146 feet more or less to center of branch; thence down the center of branch, 50 feet, thence N. 13. 30 E. 146 feet, more or less to the beginning corner, and being the lot of land recorded to me by Florence Letea, August 1921, recorded in R.
