All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Southern limits of the City of Greenville: Beginning at pin in center of 40 foot road, and running thence S. 45 E. 2.40 chains to pin on Haynie's corner; thence with Haynie's line S. 42 W. 9 chains to a pin on said Haynie's line; thence S. 31-1/2 E. 2.30 chains to a pin on H.
