WHEREAS, John R. Henry, the said Thomas P. Parker
in and by John R. Henry certain note in writing, of
even date with these presents, John R. Henry well and truly indebted to.

Thomas P. Parker \$2,333.40
in the full and just sum of Two thousand Three hundred Thirty-three dollars, to be paid to the said Thomas P. Parker and his executors, at his office in Greenville -

1/16/1910 May 23rd 1926
with interest thereon, from this 15th day of May 1910 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid John R. Henry 27th 5

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note shall become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%.

John R. Parker besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collected as part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings (any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That John R. Henry the said Thomas P. Parker in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Thomas P. Parker according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to John R. Henry, the said John R. Henry in hand well and truly paid by the said Thomas P. Parker

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas P. Parker

All that certain parcels or lot of land in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid having the following lines and bounds, being the lot purchased by me this date of the said Thomas P. Parker for which the above mentioned notes are given in part payment.

Beginning at a point in the west line of Gay Street, 150 ft. from the northwest corner of E. Washington Street and Gay Street on the north side of a 10 ft. alley, thence thence with the line of Gay Street 50 feet to the southwest corner of lot #14, thence with the line of lot #14, S. 75-0 W. 138.2 feet to a stake in the east line of an alley the southwest corner of lot #14, thence with the line of the said alley S. 13-15 E. 55.7 ft. to a stake, thence still with the line of the said alley, S. 62-40 E. 13 feet to a stake in the north line of the 10 ft. alley first above mentioned, thence with the line of the said 10 ft. alley, N. 68-52 E. 130.75 ft. to the beginning, being lot no. 13 as designated on a plat of the property of Thomas P. Parker, surveyed February 1915 and revised July 1916, April 1919 and January 1922 by R. E. Ballou, Engineer, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book "E" page 115.

This mortgage is subject to the same restriction for a period of twenty years, which is made in the deed.
