SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, W. E. Wynn, the said W. E. Wynn, in and by my certain residence, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

A. L. Bates
in the full and just sum of One Hundred (\$1300⁰⁰) Dollars, to be paid twelve years after date hereof

with interest thereon, from this day to the date of payment at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid.

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, W. E. Wynn, the said mortgagor,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, the said mortgagor,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to be paid at the time and place hereinabove mentioned, the said.

mortgagor has this day well and truly paid by the said mortgagor,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. L. Bates, and his heirs and assigns,

all that certain piece of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Paris Mountain Township and known as a portion of the land devised to me by the last will and testament of my father, J. D. Wynn, deceased and designated in the division as Tract No. 2. Adjoining lands of C. B. Wynn, Mr. Thompson and others and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning on a stone 2m, corner of Tract No. 1, and running thence N. 85 W. 16.85 to a stone, thence S. 1 W. 6.78 to a stone 20m, thence S. 93 1/2 W. 6.45' to a stone 0m, on the 'white' horse road, thence S. 28 E. 0.00 to a stone on said road, thence S. 51 3/4 W. 12.00 to a large poplar, thence A. 36 1/4 E. 8.40 to a stone, thence N. 51 1/4 E. 12.00 to a stone, thence N. 36 1/4 E. 9.12 to iron stake, thence N. 41 E. 24.37 to the beginning corner, and containing 32 1/2 acres, more or less.
