until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Fifty \$5.00 balance besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Walthour & Head Company

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the Township of Woodside, about two and one-half (2 1/2) miles east of the City of Greenville, between the Charleston & Western Railroad, and a wagon road to Batesville, containing fifteen (15) acres or less, bounded by lands now or formerly belonging to Mrs. A. A. Walker, Robert Wickliffe and James Adams, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by my father Robert Wickliffe by two deeds bearing dates October 14, 1915, and December 11, 1920, respectively and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book #6 page 241 and deed Book #70 page 249 respectively. His mortgage constituted a second lien on the above premises being junior to a certain mortgage given by me to Mrs. A. A. Walker in the principal sum of \$1,000.00 dated January 22, 1924 and recorded in Mortgage Book #87 page 218.
