until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent.*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being made thereto, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Bank of Woodruff, S. C.*

All that certain piece of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, brick Springs Township, about one mile west of the town of Greer, S.C. just off of the National Highway, and on the West side of the road leading from the National Highway to the Greer Manufacturing Co. Mill Village, and adjoining lands of the Estate of W. H. Brockman, Burgess and Haynesworth, and having the following course and distances: Beginning at a stake south east corner of two roads said corner on line of W. H. Brockman Estate, and runs thence with the road leading to the Greer Mill Village S. 44-30 E. 382 feet to a stake corner of the said Greer Mill Village road and another road thence with the last mentioned road S. 32 W. 230 feet to a stake corner of lot No. 10 of Haynesworth and Burgess lands; thence with line of lot No. 10 and 12, N. 44-30 W. 382 feet to a stake corner of lot No. 12; thence with the line of the Estate of W.
