SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said J. Hudson Williams
 in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
 even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to
 Miss Jessie M. Markley

in the full and just sum of Thirteen hundred forty-two and 20/100 (\$1342.20)
 Dollars, to be paid Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars on March 1, 1925 and the balance of Eight
 hundred forty-two and 20/100 (\$42.20) Dollars on October 1, 1925

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be
 computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
 interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
 who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent of the amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
 added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
 any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me, the said

J. Hudson Williams

in hand well and truly paid by the said

Jessie M. Markley

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
 bargain, sell and release unto the said Jessie M. Markley, all that lot of land situate in the City of
 Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the Southwest corner of Townes Street and Stone
 Avenue, having the following Metes and Bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on rear line
 also rear corner of lot heretofore conveyed by deed to Home Building and Loan Association
 (recorded in Vol. VVV, page 440); thence in a straight line 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin on
 Townes Street; thence with Townes Street N. 20 E. 140 feet to corner of Stone Avenue and
 Townes Street; thence with Stone Avenue N. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 60 feet to an iron pin, corner of said
 lot heretofore conveyed to the Home Building and Loan Association, thence with line of
 last mentioned lot 136 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the beginning. This being the same lot conveyed to me by
