Dollars, to be paid on or before the 21st, day of November A.D. 1929

with interest thereon, from date paid - Saturday Oct. 10 - 1929 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid annually Lillie B. Wertz

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$100.00 besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,

bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Lillie B. Wertz, her heirs and assigns forever: All that

certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the North side of West Mills Avenue, and being known as Lot #3 property of Louis Sherfesse, plat made by R.E. Dalton, Engr. November 1922. Beginning at a point 100.9 feet from the intersection of Church Street and Mills Avenue, running thence N. 36-51 W. 171.8 feet to joint corner of lots Nos. 2 and 3; thence N. 53-18 E. 50 feet to joint corner lots Nos. 3 and 4; thence S. 36-51 E. 164.9 feet to a stake on Mills Avenue; thence with said Mills Avenue S. 45-27 W. 50.45 feet to the point of beginning, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Wyatt Aiken Jr., by deed dated November 17th 1924, which deed is recorded in the R.M.C.
