from the S.S. & A. railroad to Piney road known as Piney

ing back along the right of way of the S.S. & A. railroad
740 feet to a corner thence extending along the line
of lot No. 8 to the road 687 feet of lot No. 8 beginning
at a stake 116 feet ahead the S.S. & A. railroad line
