bargain, sell and release unto the said Andrea C. Patterson, Trustee, and
her successors and assigns, all my right
title interest, estate, claim and demand
whatever, both at law and in equity,
in and to all that certain piece, parcel
or tract of land situate, lying and being
in the state of South Carolina and county
of Greenville, in Bates Township, in the
fork of North and South Saluda Rivers
containing one hundred and fifty (150)
acres, more or less. This is the Northern
part of the 225 acre tract conveyed by
James M. Whitmire and others to myself
and others by deed bearing date June 27th, 1914,
and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds
Conveyances for said County and State in Deed
Book 132, at page 541. The southern part of said 225
acre tract (containing 75 acres) was sold by myself
and others to W. C. Johnson by deed bearing date
November, 15th, 1919, and recorded in said office in
Deed Book 54 at page 233 thus leaving 150 acres
intended to be covered by this mortgage.

The descriptions contained in the two deeds above
referred to are hereby adopted as a part of the
description herein.

There is no other lien or encumbrance on
said land or any part thereof by mortgage,
judgment or otherwise except three prior
mortgages held by the said Mrs. A. C. Patterson
as Trustee, recorded in said office in Book
48 at page 216, and in Book 85, at page 197,
and in book 87 at page 119, respectively.
