TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, the said H. F. Burch, of the County of Greenville, South Carolina, is well and truly indebted to the said Peoples Building & Heating Company, of the County of Greenville, South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Fourteen hundred and fifty Dollars (\$1,450.00) as evidenced by a certain promissory note, in writing, bearing date with these presents, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) in hand well and truly paid by the said H. F. Burch, at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said Peoples Building & Heating Company, its heirs and assigns forever:

that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Ward #6 of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot #33, as shown on a plat, recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at page 209, plat made by R. E. Delton, C.E., and bearing date of March 1924, and being the same lot conveyed to me, the said H. F. Burch, by W. F. Robertson, Trustee, by his deed dated January 2nd, 1925, not yet recorded.

The said lot is more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe on the south-west corner of Madison and Otis Streets, and running thence along Madison Street N. 11-57 W. 63.36 feet to an iron pipe on the north-east corner of lot No. 32; thence with line of last mentioned lot S. 72 W. 133.5 feet to an iron pipe in the east line of lot No. 34; thence with line of last mentioned lot S. 7-05 E. 64.25 feet to an iron pipe on the north side of Otis Street; thence along said Street N. 72 E. 139 feet to the beginning corner. This being the same lot of land conveyed to me, the said H. F. Burch, by W. F. Robertson, Trustee, by his deed dated January 2nd, 1925, not yet recorded.
