All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on branch waters of South Tyger River, containing 129-1/2 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of David Cannon Estate, M.L. Brown, Tandy Brown, W.F. Sprouse, and Camp Creek Baptist Church and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by my husband, T.C. Wall, by deed dated Feb. 6, 1919, recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 34, page 311. This tract of land originally contained 133 acres, as will appear by deed of William M. Thomas, C.E.G.D., to Larkin J. Cannon, dated December 2, 1861, recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 2, page 420, the following tracts having been subsequently conveyed off: One tract of 7-1/2 acres to A.J. Bomar (now owned by W.F. Sprouse), and One acre to Camp Creek Baptist Church.
