with interest thereon, from date of the note at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$50.00

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Ed. C. Cerdts his heirs and assigns forever; all those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the 5th Ward of the city of Greenville, County and state aforesaid on the North side of Rhett Street and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: The larger or the first lot beginning at an iron pine 3X on said Rhett street 100 feet from the corner of Rhett and Markley streets and running thence along said Rhett street N. 70% E. 96 feet to an iron pine 3X Caleys Corner; thence with Caleys line N. 19% W. 64 feet to an iron pine 3X, Mrs. Linsleys Corner; thence with her line S. 71 W. 95 feet to an iron pine 3X; thence S. 18% E. 65 feet to the beginning corner containing 6160 sq. feet more or less.

The other parcel or lot of land embraces a small strip next adjoining the above described lot on the west, having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pine 3X on Rhett street and running thence with said Rhett street N. 70% feet to an iron pine 3X corner of first described lot; thence with line of said lot N. 18% W. to an iron pine 3X, on Mrs. Linsleys line; thence with her line S. 71 W. 4 feet to an iron pine 3X, Mrs. P. McHughes corner; thence with her line S. 18% E. 65 feet to the beginning corner. The above described lot forming one lot containing 6420 sq. feet more or less and being the same lots of land conveyed to me by Anna Gilmer by deed dated 15th day of March 1920, which deed is recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Book Vol. 90 Page 98.
