with interest thereon, from *February 3, 1925* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *Annually*.

.....until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of.

*10* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by *any* proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. B. Brumlett*,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated lying, and being in the state and county aforesaid, in *Greenville* townships near *Sainteens* between *the* beginning at a stone near sweet gum and big a *book* well and running *E. 84 1/4 N. 17.00 chains* to a stake in the field, thence *E. 24° S. 11.78 chains* to another post thence *E. 74 3/4 S. 13.21* to a stone on the bank of ditch, thence *E. 3 3/4 N. 90 3'* to beginning corner and containing fifteen acres *4 1/10* acres (*16 5/6*), more or less, according to survey and plat made by *W. A. Christopher* Feb. 12, 1918 bounded by *R. H. Mason* on the north and the east by *John Johnson* and *Lee Smith* on the south side by *J. B. Brumlett* and on the west by *M. M.
