WHEREAS, I, Frederica L. Perry, the said wife of D. D. Davenport, deceased, in and by copy certain even date with these presents, do the necessary bonds of my note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to Peoples National Bank, Executors of the will of D. D. Davenport, deceased, in the full and just sum of \$1,000.00 Dollars, to be paid at the time and place of maturity of this note, at the rate of seven per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten percent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Frederica L. Perry, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Peoples National Bank, as Executrix will of D. D. Davenport, deceased, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said

Frederica L. Perry, in hand well and truly paid by the said Peoples National Bank, as Executor

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Peoples National Bank, as Executrix of the will of D. D. Davenport, deceased. All that certain lot of land in the County of Greenville, with the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of David Street at Grandys corner and running thence with Grandys line S. 37 W. 17 1/2 feet to iron pin on Donvilles line hence with Donvilles line N. 29 W. 69 feet and 4 inches to iron pin, thence N. 57 E. 17 1/2 feet to iron pin on David Street, thence with David Street S. 25 1/3 E. 41 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Ade R. Bonneau by deed dated day of December, 1920, recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 74 at page 111.
