 in the full and just sum of twenty-two hundred Fifty (\$2250.00)
 Dollars, to be paid in monthly installments of \$25.00 due and
 payable on the first day of each month hereafter
 beginning November 1, 1924, until paid in full

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be
 computed and paid quarterly
 until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
 interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
 who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of five percent.
