having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin near center of side-walk at the northeast corner of Main and
Curtis Streets and running thence along Curtis Street N. 67.00 E. 60 ft. to an iron pin
in said side-walk; thence N. 22-45 W. 51 ft. 2 in. to an iron pin on Bozeman's line;
thence S. 67-15 W. 60 ft. to an iron pin on edge of side-walk on Main Street; thence
