WHEREAS, L. W. Paris, the said President of Paris Co., in and by my certain note..... in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to.....

in the full and just sum of Two thousand dollars (\$2000.00)

Dollars, to be paid one year from the date of this note

with interest thereon, from Sept. 1st at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid.....

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of less than costs

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note..... to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That..... the said L. W. Paris

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said.....

according to the terms of said note..... and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars 3, the said.....

in hand well and truly paid by the said L. W. Paris on the 2nd day of October 1924 in consideration of the said note.....

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Auditorium Advertising Agency, Inc.

All of that certain lot of land in Greenville, South Carolina, and County aforesaid, fronting on the south side of Blasingame Street (near the Bequest Road) being known and designated as a portion of lot no. 9 according to the plat of property of James D. and Lona C. Peeler, made by R. E. Dalton, Engr. October 1923, and recorded in Plat Book 2, at page 141 having the following widths and bounds, to wit:
