Dollars, to be paid One year from Date

with interest thereon, from Date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of One Hundred Dollars, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *W. P. Nesbitt, his heirs and assigns*,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Ward 3 of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, commencing at an iron post on the south side of Perry Avenue, corner of Mrs. Dick's lots, thence South 18<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> W. along line of Mrs. Dick's lot 191 feet to an iron pin on the 20 foot alley; thence S. 71<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> E. along said alley 195 feet to an iron pin on lot formerly owned by Walter West; thence N. 18<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> E. along line of lots formerly owned by Walter West 191 feet to an iron pin on Perry Avenue; thence N. 71<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> N. along Perry Ave 195 feet to an iron pin at the beginning corner, as shown on plat of Estate of O.
