with interest thereon from *date* until paid in full; at the rate of *Eight* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *a reasonable amount*

OF *10% of the amount* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereunto had, or will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. J. Stuart*

All those two lots of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 12 Block "D" in Sub-division known as "Park Place", as shown on plat of said Sub-division recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat book "A" at page 119, said lot having a frontage on Second Avenue of 50 feet and running back in parallel lines 150 feet to a ten foot alley.

Also that lot of land situate, lying and being in said County and State, being known and designated as part of Lot No. 10 Block "D" said sub-division as above referred to, said lot having a frontage of five feet and running back in parallel lines a depth of 150 feet to the above referred to ten foot alley, said five feet of lot No. 10 being next to and adjoining lot No. 12, referred to heretofore being the same lots conveyed to me by W.
