TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That we, E.M. Harling and W.J. Patrick, of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, we, the said E.M. Harling and W.J. Patrick, in and by our certain note or obligation, bearing the 4th day of March 1926

we are indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Twelve Hundred Fifty and no/100 (\$1250.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 4th day of March A. Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$19.17 Dollars, (\$12.50)

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$6.67 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of \$17.50 Dollars,

((\$12.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$5.00

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$12.83

Dollars, (\$12.50) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$3.30

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition hereof written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that we, the said E.M. Harling and W.J. Patrick, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,

according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to us the said E.M. Harling and W.J. Patrick,

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

A portion of west Knoxville on the corner of Oak (formerly known as Stradley) and Dietler (formerly known as Woodside) Streets, and having a frontage of one hundred (100) feet on Dietler (formerly known as Woodside Street), and a frontage of one hundred (100) feet on Oak (formerly known as Stradley Street), and containing 70.050 square feet, and being the same lot conveyed to us by George W. Batson by deed dated of even date herewith to be recorded.
