WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of One thousand no. 100 Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

In Greenville Township, on Sullivan Street, in Ward 6 of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on A.D.L. Barksdale's lot on Sullivan Street; thence along said Street N. 88-52 W. 75 feet to an iron pin in center of alley; thence with center of said alley, due N. 162.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 88-52 E. 41.3 feet to an iron pin at the corner of W.C. Stubbs' lot; thence S. 11-44 E. 166.2 feet to the beginning corner, being a part of the Hammett lands, being the same conveyed to me by J.C. Milford by deed dated July 20, 1914, and recorded in Book 15, Page 674.
