THIS INDENTURE, made this 21st day of January, A. D. 1928
by and between J. G. Saunders, J. G. Saunders Jr. and J. B. Seaton

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS ~~PERPETUAL~~ BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Three thousand five hundred and no/100
(\$3,300.00) Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure. #7474

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that piece of land, known as Lot "I" in "Map No. 2" of "Saunders' Subdivision" as shown on a plat made by Carlton Hayes, Surveyor, September, 1927, and recorded in Plat Book "B", at page 90, in the R.M.C. office of Greenville County, a hill having, according to said plat, the following dimensions and boundaries, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in a neck on north side of Parson's Creek, a distance 147.8 feet from the northeast corner of McDonald and Parson's Creek road, running due west with Parson's Creek street N. 66-33 W. S. S. feet to a point in corner of Lot I; thence N. 19-30 E. 147.8 feet to a point in an 10 foot alley; thence S. 66-02-05-44 E. 147.8 feet to a corner point on corner of Lot No. 39, thence S. 17-00 E. 147.8 feet to a corner point on the north side of Parson's Creek, the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to me by C. E. McDraway, March 1st, 1927, by deed recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. , Page .
