confirming in said successor trustee all the right, title and interest of the retiring trustee in and to the Trust Estate and said rights, powers, trusts, duties and obligations; and the retiring trustee shall also, upon like request and upon payment of its unpaid compensation and expenses as aforesaid, pay over, assign and deliver to the successor trustee any money and other property subject to the lien of this Indenture then held by it, and deliver any and all records, or copies thereof, in respect of the trusts hereunder which it may have; and upon request of any such successor trustee the Companies shall execute, acknowledge and deliver any and all deeds, conveyances or other instruments in writing for more fully and certainly vesting in and confirming to such successor trustee said estates, properties, rights, powers and duties.

§ 9.06. If at any time it shall be desirable in the opinion of the Companies or the Trustee to have an additional trustee or trustees as co-trustee or co-trustees hereunder, either individual or corporate, the Trustee shall select such additional trustee or trustees to act as co-trustee or cotrustees of all or any part of the Trust Estate jointly with the Trustee originally named herein, or its successor or successors, or to act as a separate trustee or trustees hereunder or of any part of the Trust Estate, and the Trustee and the Companies shall unite in appointing such additional trustee or trustees hereunder. Upon such appointment, the title of the Trustee to all or part of the Trust Estate as specified in such appointment shall immediately, and without further evidence of transfer, vest in such co-trustee or co-trustees either jointly with the Trustee or separately according to the terms of such appointment, but the Trustee or the Companies or both shall nevertheless execute, acknowledge and deliver to such co-trustee or co-trustees such conveyances and transfers as the Trustee may deem requisite or desirable to vest or confirm said Trust Estate in the co-trustee or co-trustees.
