(13). Louisville & Nashville Railroad Company, dated March 1, 1904, concerning use of tracks between Jellico, Tenn., and Hyde, Tenn., a distance of 8.60 miles.

(14). Louisville & Nashville Railroad Company (Nashville, Chattanooga and St. Louis Railway), dated June 11, 1921, as supplemented, concerning use of tracks between Wauhatchie, Tenn., and Stevenson, Ala., a distance of 32.90 miles.

(15). Memphis and Charleston Railway Company, dated March 3, 1898, concerning use of main track in the State of Mississippi between Alabama-Mississippi State Line on the east and Mississippi-Tennessee State Line on the west, a distance of 34.13 miles.

(16) Monon Railroad (Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville Railway Company) dated September 27, 1938, as supplemented, concerning use of main track of Monon Railroad between West Baden and French Lick, Indiana, a distance of 1.47 miles.

(17). Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company (Washington Southern Railway Company), dated September 17, 1901, concerning use of tracks between Seminary Jct., Va., and the south end of Long Bridge, Arlington County, Va., a distance of 5.87 miles, in so far as the same is not superseded by item (4) under Freight Terminal Agreements.

(18). Seaboard Air Line Railroad Company (Seaboard Air Line Railway), dated January 5, 1915, concerning use of tracks between Raleigh and Cary, N. C., a distance of 7.73 miles.
