from the 14th, day of April 1925, and,

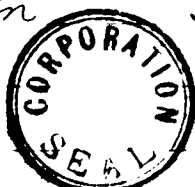
Whereas the Mortgagor has expressly requested an ex-
tension of time of payment of the indebtedness set
forth in said bond and mortgage, and,

Whereas the acceptance of this agreement is condi-
tioned upon the extension of the time of payment
of the above bond and mortgage, it is hereby agreed
that the said bond and mortgage shall become
due and payable as follows:

One Hundred and Twenty Dollars on the first day of
October, 1925 and a like amount on the first day of
April, 1926, and on the first day of each October and
April thereafter until and including April 1st, 1939
and the balance then remaining unpaid on October
1st, 1939 with interest at the rate of 6½ per centum per
annum payable semi-annually on the first day of
each October and April until paid, such extension
of payment to take effect only if the above assign-
ment is accepted and the purchase of the above
bond and mortgage by the assignee herein is completed.
