Whereas, I the said John W. Lloyd, in and by my certain Seal, at this day being the 1st day of January, 1880, did seal and bind myself and my wife, Emily Bell and bound myself to the Shenandoah Life Insurance Company, Inc., of Roanoke Va., in the sum of Eight Thousand and Five Hundred (\$8,500.00) Dollars, conditioned for the payment of said money to the United States, or to the Bell said just sum of Eight Thousand and Five hundred (\$8,500.00) dollars, at the time payable one thousand and date, with interest from date set forth above (6%) per cent per annum payable annually, all interest to be paid before due date to have interest accumulate and principal and provide further for the attorney fees of five (5%) per cent of principal note is placed with the attorney for collection by suit or otherwise in any of the said bonds, conditions thereof, reference being therunto will more fully appear.

Lloyd, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, the said Shenandoah Life Insurance Company, Inc., of Roanoke, Va., its successors and assigns.
