

Main Street Extension, a traverse line being as follows: S. 2-40 W. 20 feet to a stake; thence N. 54-00 W. 800 feet to a stake, N. 65-12 W. 285 feet to a point over culvert, thence along north Main Street Extension, diagonally crossing same, N. 14-18 E. 1745.4 feet to a stake on west edge of Main Street Extension; thence along property of Henderson et al, N. 24-20 W. 868.4 feet to point of beginning; containing 41.50 acres, more or less; being the same tract of land conveyed to the mortgagee by D. W. Moore and Lucy L. Hindman, by deed dated July 8, 1925, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Volume 118, page 62.

(2) Beginning at a point at the south edge of the concrete pavement on the National Highway, joint corner of County property and property of Henderson and Hobbs, and running thence with line of County property, S. 35-00 E. 416 feet to a stone; thence ^{thence S. 48-10 W. 233.25 feet to a stone} S. 48-30 W. 505 feet to a stone; thence S. 37-25 E. 336.7 feet to a stone; thence S. 14-55 W. 130 feet to a stone; thence S. 24-25 E. 79.6 feet to a stone; thence S. 21-50 E. 242.6 feet to a stone; thence S. 6 W. 270 feet to a stake in center of Richland Creek; thence with center of Richland Creek, approximately S. 81-20 E. 233.2 feet to a stake; thence still with Richland Creek, S. 75-50 E. 135 feet to an iron pin near the eastern edge of north Main Street; thence along said north Main Street, N. 14-05 E. 1763 feet to an iron pin, corner of D. W. Moore property; thence N. 24-45 W. 868.4 feet to a point on the southern edge of the concrete pavement in the National Highway; thence with the southern edge of said concrete pavement and with the National Highway, S. 55-20 E. 924.2 feet to the beginning, and having, according to a survey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, July 1923, 48.70 acres, more or less.

(3) That tract of land beginning at a stake 200 feet from Rutherford Road, on line of other property of Henderson & Hobbs, and corner of land now or formerly owned by Carrie Adams; thence N. 34.47 W. 213.4 feet to a stake; thence S. 54-32 W. 40 feet to a stake; thence S. 34.47 E. 213.4 feet to a stake in line of land now or formerly owned by Carrie Adams; thence N. 55.06 E. 40 feet to the beginning corner. This tract adjoins the right of way of the Southern Railroad for forty (40) feet.

(4) That tract of land beginning at a stone on the west side of Rutherford Road, at point where land of A. G. New adjoins the property of Greenville County, and running thence N. 34.47 W. 412.4 feet along line between said properties to a stone on the line
