in and by certain day even date with these presents, A.M. Parish and T. L. Gower  
in the full and just sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00)

Dollars, to be paid two (2) years after date with the right to anticipate payments at any time

with interest thereon from dates computed and paid Annually at the rate of per cent. per annum, to be

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of such cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10

All that certain lot or parcel of land lying and being on the Southwest side of Augusta Street, City of Greenville County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, do wit: - Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Augusta Street, which iron pin is 94 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet from the Southwest corner of Augusta Street and Milledge Avenue, run thence with the line of the lot conveyed by R. A. Mills to B. L. Rushing, S. 54-06 W. 150 feet to an iron pin in line of lot no. 7, thence S. 29-02 E. 78 feet to an iron pin, thence with line of lot deeded to W. M. Manning N. 54-06 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on Augusta Street, thence with the South side of Augusta Street, N. 29-02 W. 78 feet to the point of beginning, being the same lot of land this day conveyed to me by W.
