SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Louise J. Watkins*,  
 in and by *my* certain *(Promises to pay)* note, in writing, of  
 even date with these presents,

*Banks of Greenville &c as Executor and Trustee of the Estate of Dr. J. W. White deceased, Fourteen Hundred (\$1400.00) well and truly indebted to The First National*

*Dollars, to be paid the following day, year after date)*

with interest thereon, from *March 1st 1926* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *quarterly*.

*Unpaid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of*

*besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, is collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto shall be made as will more fully appear).*

NOW, KNOW YE, THAT, *I*, the said *Louise J. Watkins*,

in consideration of the said sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *The First National Bank* as *Executor*,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

*Louise J. Watkins*,

in hand well and truly paid by the said *The First National Bank* as *Executor and Trustee*,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said *The First National Bank* as *Executor and Trustee*,

*All that certain piece - parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina on the Road leading from the Old Spartanburg Road to Paris and being known and designated as tract no 6 as shown on plat made by C. J. Millard October 1924 and having the following lines and bounds, according to said plat to wit;*

*Beginning at an iron pipe in said road corner of Lat. No. 7 and running thence with line of Lat. No. 7 & 77-17 N. 495.2 feet to pipe; thence S. 74° 40' E. 142.6 feet to pipe; thence S. 6-26 W. 162 feet to 20 foot alley; thence with line of said alley N. 66° 58' E. 602.8 feet to road leading to Paris thence with said road N. 23 W. 190 feet to the beginning corner and containing 2.96 acres more or less. Being the same tract of land conveyed to me by *The First National Bank of Greenville J. C. as Exec. and Trustee by deed of even date herewith, the same not yet recorded.**
